Dear Parents

I plan to begin small homework tasks in the next week or two. Due to Covid19 restrictions and regulations, our homework routine will be slightly different than usual. We still plan to send home weekly reading books. These will be sent home on a Friday and should be returned the following Thursday (We can then quarantine the books for 72 hours before they can be used with other children.) Your co-operation in timely return of books to allow for quarantining is greatly appreciated.

I also ask that the children use book bags to carry their books. Unfortunately, we have to charge for these. They will be available from school shortly at a cost of £3.50.

Additional homework will be issued each week via Seesaw. You may already be familiar with this App through the Nursery or through use with older siblings during lockdown. Please see attached instructions of how to install this App on your device:

Tips:

- Please ensure that you install **Seesaw 'Class'** (not 'Family'). The Seesaw 'Class' App is the interactive one which allows your child to complete and send back work electronically.
- If possible, please use separate email addresses for each child (if you have more than one child using Seesaw). This ensures that their work goes to the correct class teacher.
- Please keep note of the email address and password that you use to register your child.



NB – This registration code is only valid until 16th September. Please register before this date.
